Disbursements

Disbursements are items arranged for and possibly paid for on your behalf by us. You are expected to pay for these items at the time the contract is entered into. The following are some items that are often identified as disbursements.

Cemetery or Crematorium – this is a fee charged by the Cemetery for Interment of a casket or Urn into an existing family plot

or

Cremation fee applying when an individual is cremated.

Varies depending on organization for issuing a certificate that allows cremation to take place.

Coroner's fee – this is a fee charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation to take place. The fee is set by the Chief Coroner for Ontario.

Clergy honorarium – this is an amount paid to the clergy for their services. In some cases the amount is set by the clergy, in others it is an amount to be determined by you. From \$200

Newspaper or radio notices – these are charges for death notices placed in newspapers or radio or other media outlets.

Municipal death registration fee – this is a fee charged by the local municipality to register the death. The fee is set by the municipality and may very from year to year according to Municipal budget.

Organist honorarium - this is an amount paid to the organist for their services. In some cases the amount is set by the organist, in others it is an amount to be determined by you.

Florist – this is the amount that is paid to the florist for their services including any taxes and delivery. This amount is to be determined by you.

Payment

Unless otherwise specified, payment is due within 30 days of signing the contract. Payment may be made by cash, cheque, Bank Draft. We do accept most major credit cards (credit card use is restricted to 7 days following date of service). We reserve the right to charge a convenience fee equal to the credit card processing to a max of 2%. Payment plans are also available to meet most budgets. Financing charges apply to payment plans. Beyond the allotted time, interest will be charged at a rate of 2% which is equivalent to 24% per annum (APR).

If you are prepaying for services or supplies, pre-authorized chequing is also available.

<u>Funding</u>

For your convenience, we offer two funding options when prepaying services or supplies. When prepaying, you pay for the services and supplies today and the money will be used to pay for the services and supplies when they are delivered at the time of death.

Trust: You may pay the money directly to us and we will place it in trust, where it will accrue interest until the contract is fulfilled (when the services and supplies are delivered) or the contract is cancelled.

Insurance: You may purchase an insurance contract where the proceeds of the insurance contract will be used to pay for the services or supplies at the time they are delivered or the contract is cancelled.
